**Stamps:** Traditional Labels

**Dies:** Stylish Shapes, Traditional Labels, Branching Out (arms)

**Ink:** Shaded Spruce

**Cardstock:** Thick Basic White, Shaded Spruce, Whispers of Texture, Real Red, Basic Black, Early Espresso

**Designer Paper:** Elegant Pine Snowflakes 12x12

**Accessories:** Basic Rhinestones, Real Red Shiny Ribbon, Low Profile Dots with Black Sharpie marker or Black dots, Rhinestones

**Measurements:** Card is 4-1/4" x 6-1/4" when folded.

**Shaded Spruce Cardstock:** 6-1/4" x 8-1/2", scored in landscape position at 4-1/4" for a side fold card.

**Snowflake Designer Paper:** 4" x 6".

**Textured White Cardstock:** 4" x 2-1/2" to cut snowbank.

**Thick White Cardstock:** 3" x 5-1/2" to cut 2 circles and banner. Head is 1-3/4" circle. Body is 2-1/2" circle.

**Basic Black Cardstock:** 1-1/2" x 3". Hat is 1" square plus 1/2" banner.

**Real Red cardstock:** 1/4" x 1" for hat.

**Early Espresso Cardstock:** 2" x 3" to cut arms.

**Ribbon:** 2-1/2" and 6".
